## Tennis League Policy

All I'On Club league teams will consist of I'On Club Members only.

The only exception to this policy is in cases where additional players are necessary to field a specific team at a specific level of play. If a team captain, with the input of the Director of Tennis, can identify at least 14 Member players who are of the team level and who have interest in playing, non-members will not be permitted on that team.

Any request to include a non-member on an I'On Club league team must be made to the Director of Tennis before a team captain may enter a roster. By requesting that a non-member be added to a roster, the team and team captain agree that a new club Member who joins the Club after the roster is submitted, and who is of the team level in the opinion of the Director of Tennis, will be added to a team roster, replacing the non-member.

During the course of the league season, if a team experiences a drop in the availability of players on a previously entered roster, the team captain may make a request to the Director of Tennis to add new players to the roster. If the team captain, with input from the Director of Tennis, cannot identify Members who are of the team level and who have an interest in playing, a specific number of non-members will be permitted to be added to the team roster. The number of non-member players to be added will be at the sole discretion of the Director of Tennis.

Non-member who are approved to play on the I'On Club league team will be billed a \$100 non-member league registration fee for each season of play for each team (if more than one team). In addition, payment of the regular guest fees will apply each time the non-member practices with the team.

Certified Professionals (USPTA or PTR), who are non-members, may play on I'On Club league teams within the same conditions as previously outlined. As a professional courtesy, their \$100 non-member league registration fee will be waived. The appropriate guest fees are still applicable when they join a team practice.
